### **Hall of Honor accepting nominations, moves induction banquet to fall**

DEER PARK – The Felton F. Waggoner Hall of Honor, which honors Deer Park graduates who make an outstanding contribution to their profession or community, is currently accepting nominations for the next group of inductees.

In order to be considered for the Hall of Honor, a nominee must be a Deer Park High School graduate. Nomination applications are available on the district website at [www.dpsid.org/~dpef/special\\_events.htm](http://www.dpsid.org/~dpef/special_events.htm) or at the district Administration Building, which is located at 203 Ivy Avenue in Deer Park. The nomination deadline is June 16.

In related news, the Deer Park Education Foundation has moved the date for the upcoming induction banquet for the hall of honor. In the past, the banquet took place in the spring. However, it will now be held in the fall to coordinate with Homecoming activities and encourage alumni participation.

The foundation's 13th Annual Felton F. Waggoner Hall of Honor Induction Banquet will take place on Saturday, October 11. The banquet is held as a fundraiser for the foundation, a non-profit organization that works in partnership with Deer Park ISD's schools to fund innovative, effective programs offering students the opportunity to have a creative and diverse educational experience. Donations made to the foundation provide funds for educational opportunities above and beyond the normal operating

budget of the school district. During the 2007-08 school year, the foundation presented \$76,993 in grants to the district.

The Felton F. Waggoner Hall of Honor was conceived in 1996 by Ray Landers, retired deputy superintendent for instruction for DPISD. The hall is named in memory of the long-time Deer Park High School principal who oversaw the high school from 1950-1973. Currently, the hall of honor includes 56 outstanding Deer Park graduates.
